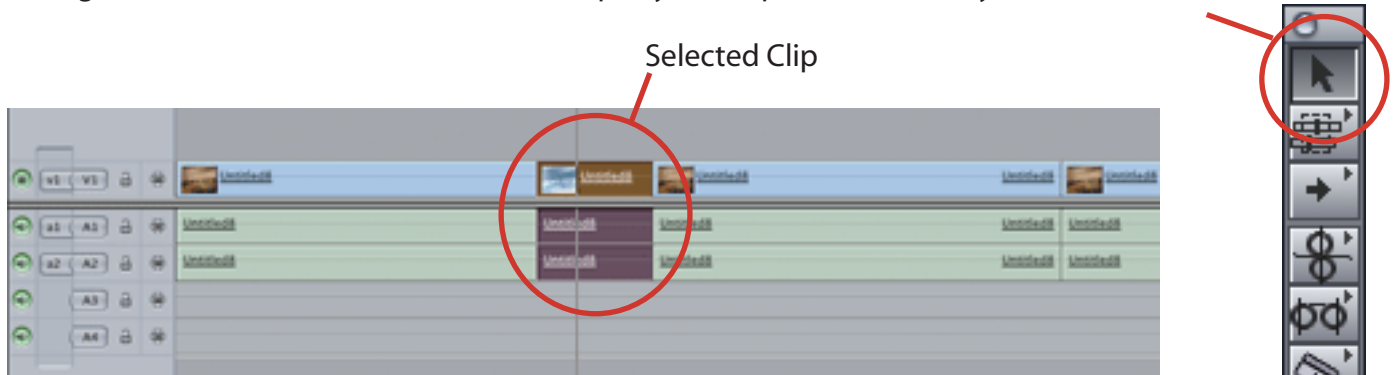


Final Cut Pro - Adding Effects

Menu Method

1) Using the Arrow selection tool, select the clip in your sequence to which you would like to add an effect.



2) After selecting the clip, go to the "Effects" menu and either choose "Video Filters" or "Audio Filters".

3) A series of sub-menus will pop out. Navigate to the effect that you would like to try.

4) Once the effect you would like is highlighted release the mouse button.

5) To adjust the effect parameters, double click on the effected clip in the timeline.

This causes the clip to open in the Viewer window.

6) In the Viewer window, click on the Filters tab. The applied video filter will be listed along with its attributes. Adjust the various attribute parameters to manipulate the effect. Changes should be visible in the Canvas window.

7) To delete the filter, click the filter's title in the Viewer filter tab and press the delete key.

Browser Method

1) In the Browser window, click on the Effects tab.

2) Open up the Video Filters folder.

3) Find the effect from the subfolders which you would like to try.

4) Click the icon by the effect title and drag the effect onto the clip in your sequence that you would like to effect.

5) To adjust the effect parameters, double-click on the effected clip in the timeline. This causes the clip to open in the Viewer window.

6) In the Viewer window, click on the Filters tab. The applied video filter will be listed along with its attributes. Adjust the various attribute parameters to manipulate the effect. Changes should be visible in the Canvas window.

7) To delete the filter, click the filter's title in the Viewer filter tab and press the delete key.
