

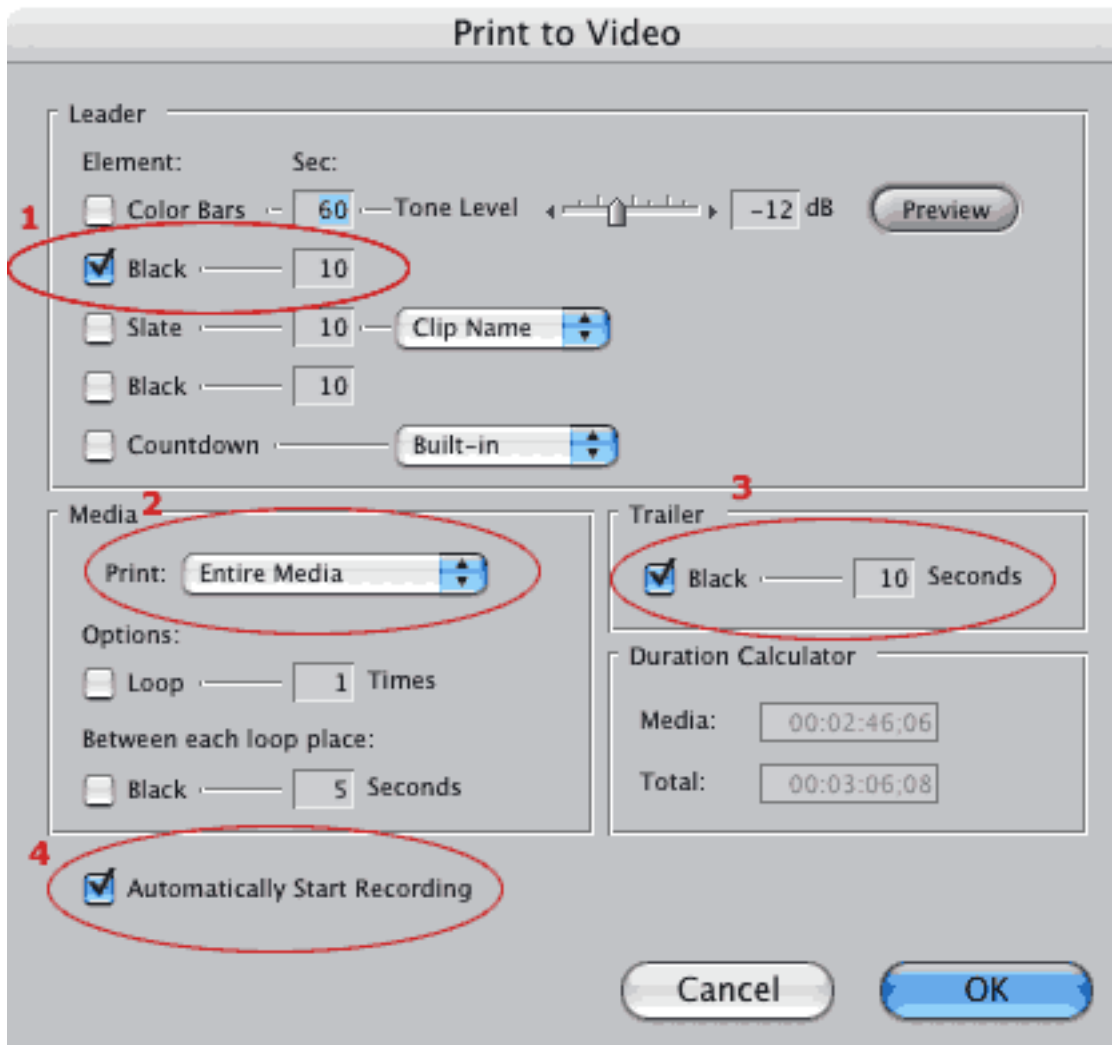
Final Cut Pro • Back to Videotape

SETUP

- 1) Make sure the DVcam input is set to "Input DV".
- 1b) If DVcam deck was off, turn it on and go to the Final Cut Pro "View" menu and choose "Refresh A/V Devices".
- 2) Put your tape into the DVcam deck and cue it to the spot where you want to record (blank area of the tape or footage that you don't mind recording over).
- 3) In the Browser window, highlight the edited sequence that you want to record to video tape.
- 4) Go to the "File" menu and choose "Print to Video".

ADJUSTING THE PRINT TO VIDEO SETTINGS

- 5) Change the settings in the "Print to Video" window to match the following screen shot:



- 6) Click the "OK" button. The sequence will record to your tape. When it is finished it will stop. Do not stop the deck when your sequence finishes and the screen turns black. Wait for the deck to stop itself.

TIPS

To abort the process after it has started recording, press the escape key
