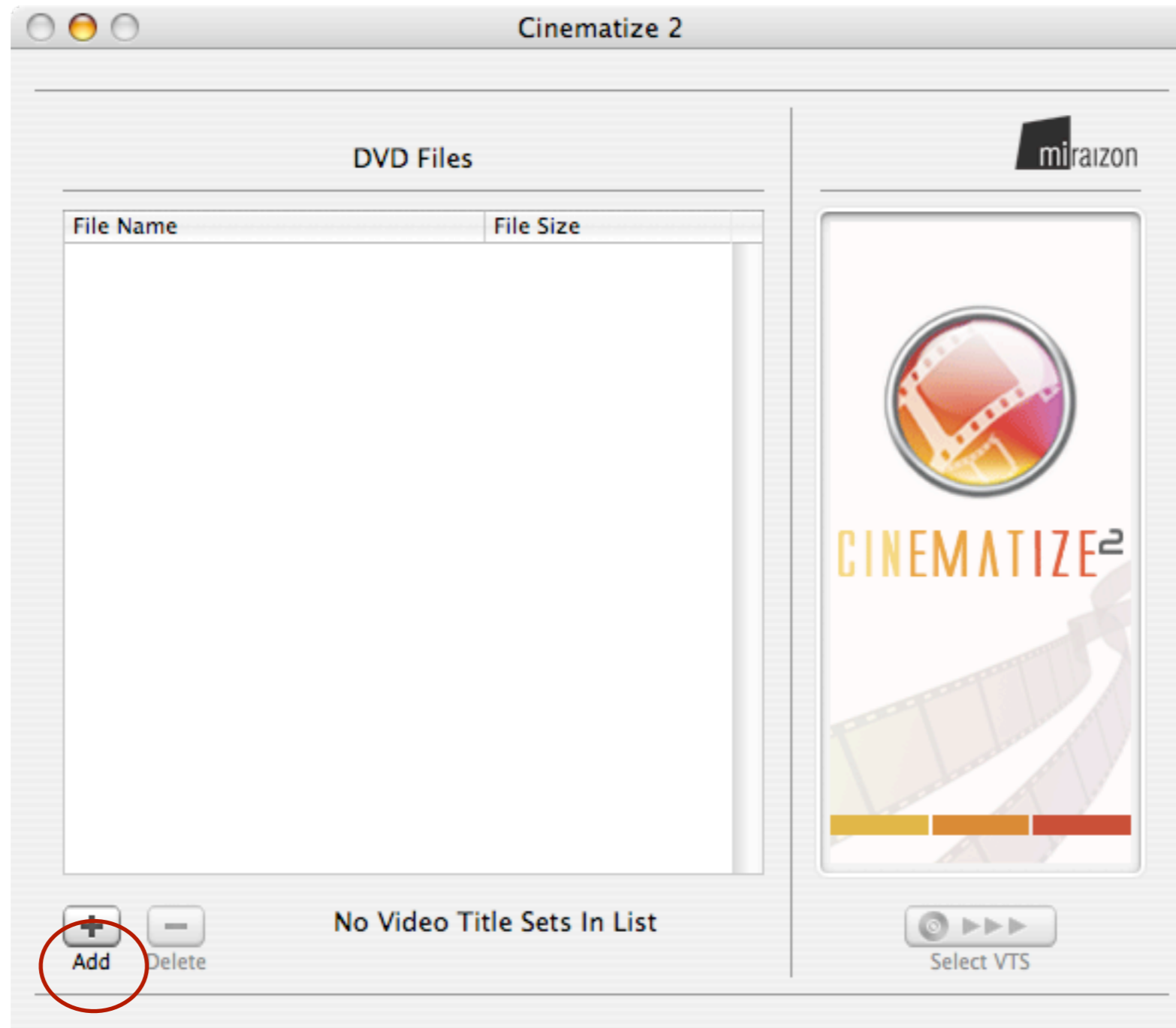


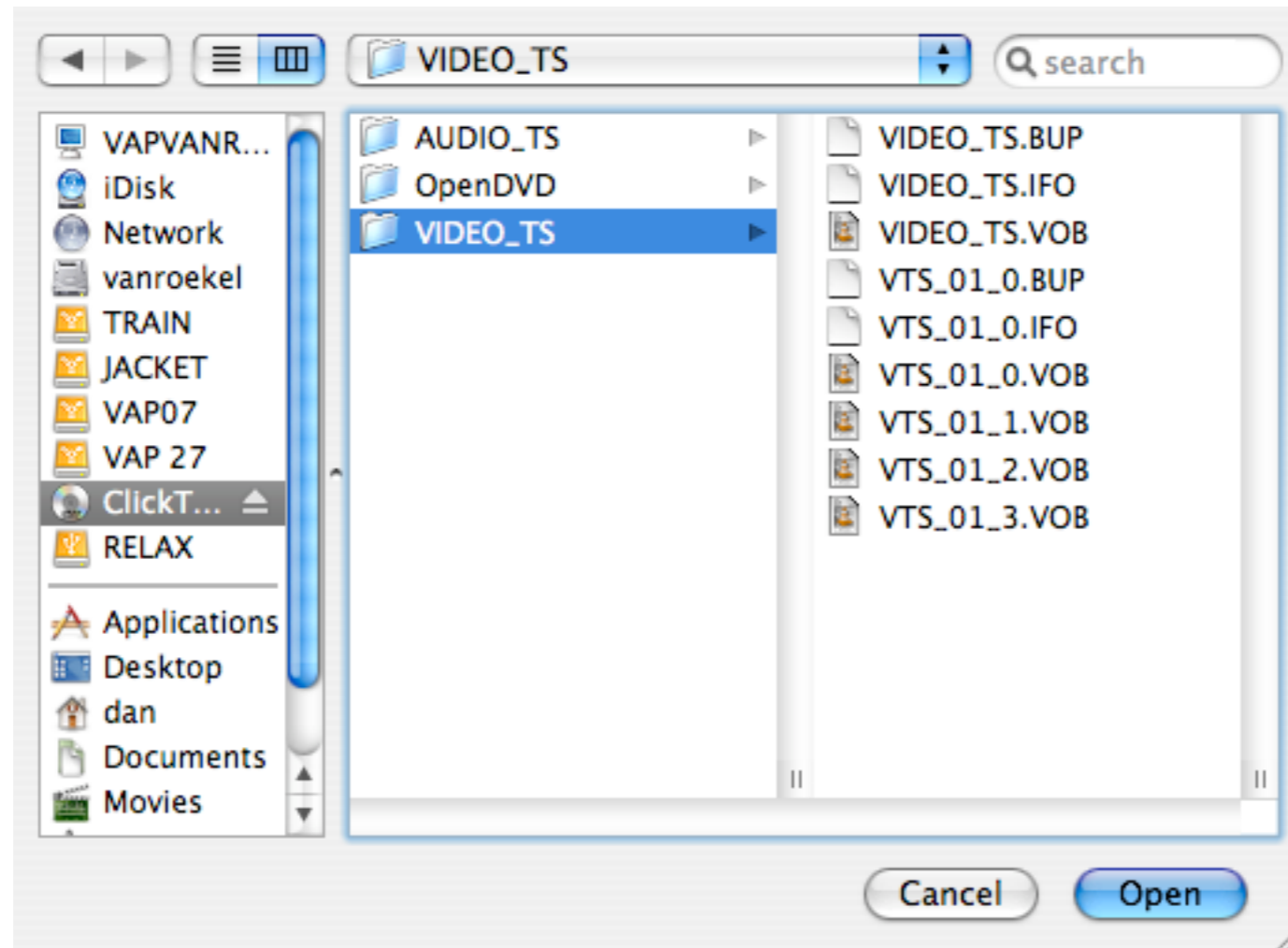
Cinematize to Final Cut Pro

How to extract video material from a DVD for use in Final Cut Pro

- 1) Insert the DVD into your computer.
- 2) Open Cinematize.
- 3) If Cinematize warns you that the DVD is copyright protected, use MacTheRipper, an application found in the Multimedia folder, to remove the encryption.
- 4) In Cinematize, click the Add button in the lower left corner of the Cinematize window.

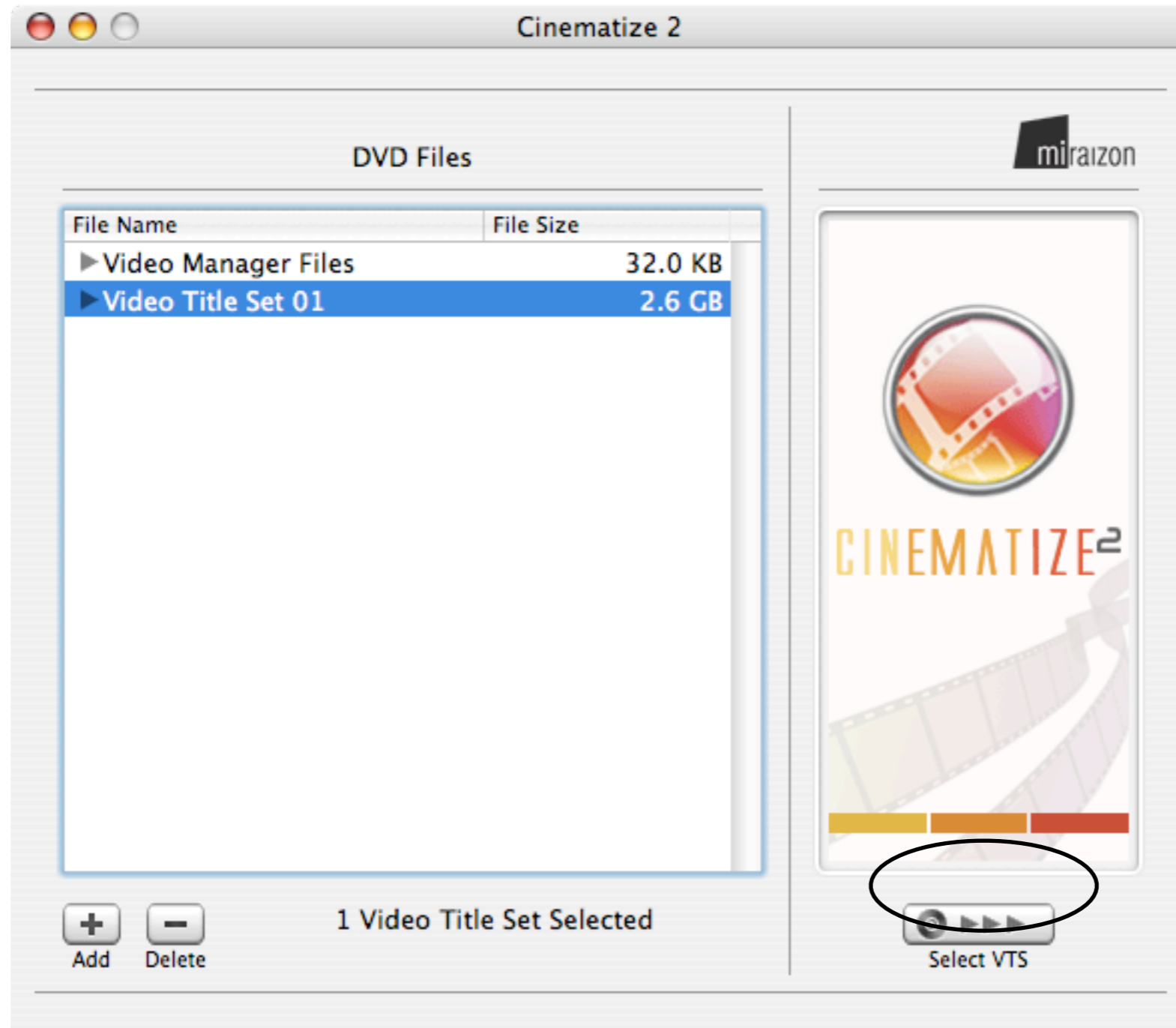


- 4) Choose the VIDEO_TS folder on the DVD or from your MacTheRipper folder.
- 5) Click the Open button.



- 5) Click to highlight one of the Video Title Sets from the list.
- 6) Click the Select VTS button in the lower right corner of the Cinematize window.

Note: Usually the Video Title Sets with the actual movie are around 1-4 GB.
Smaller Sets of less than 100MB are usually the DVD menus and extras.



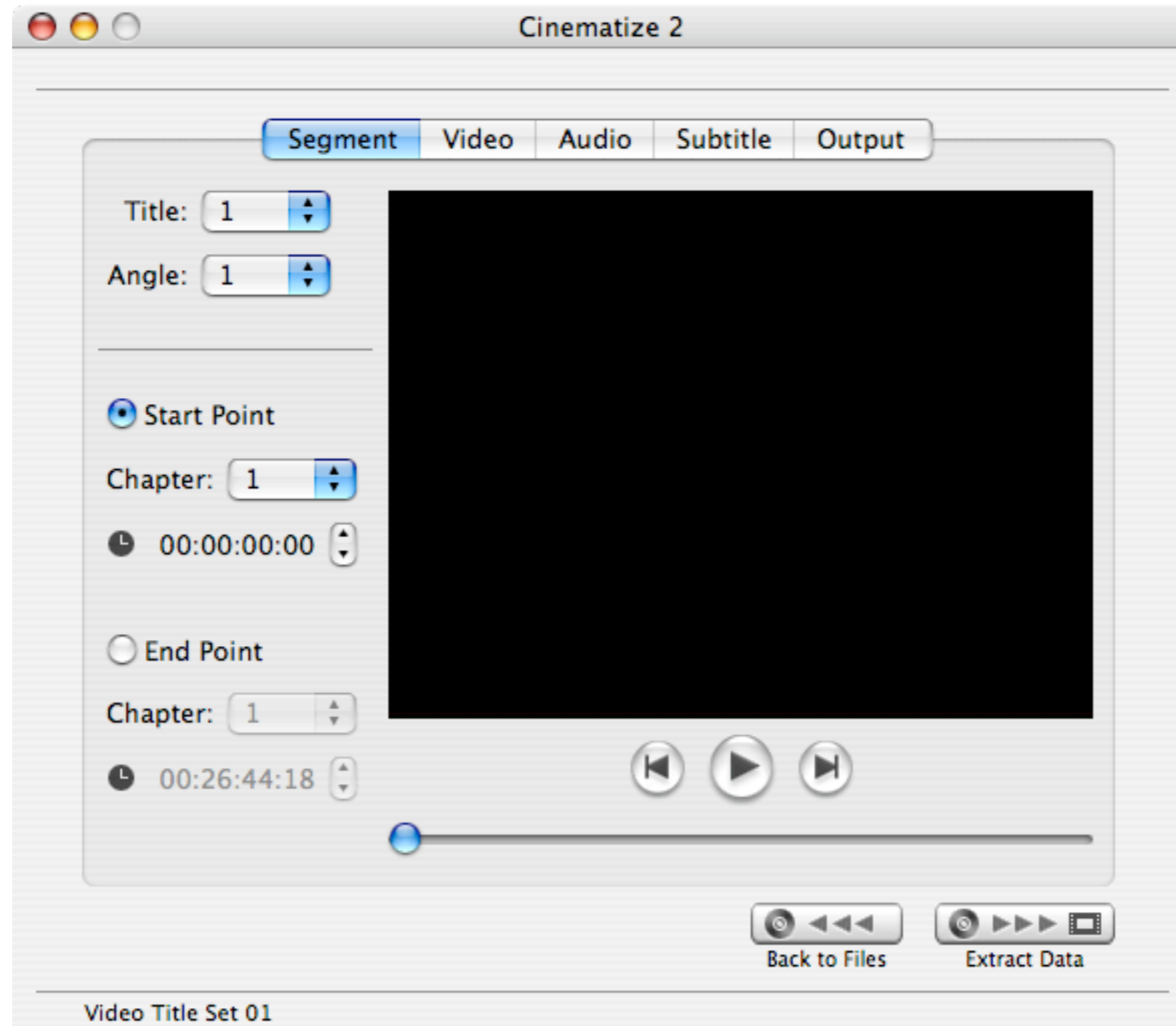
7) Once the VTS is ready, the Cinematize window will have a row of five tabs at the top.

8) Segment Tab

A) You can view the chapters by selecting a chapter from the pop-up menu and then using the play buttons and slider.

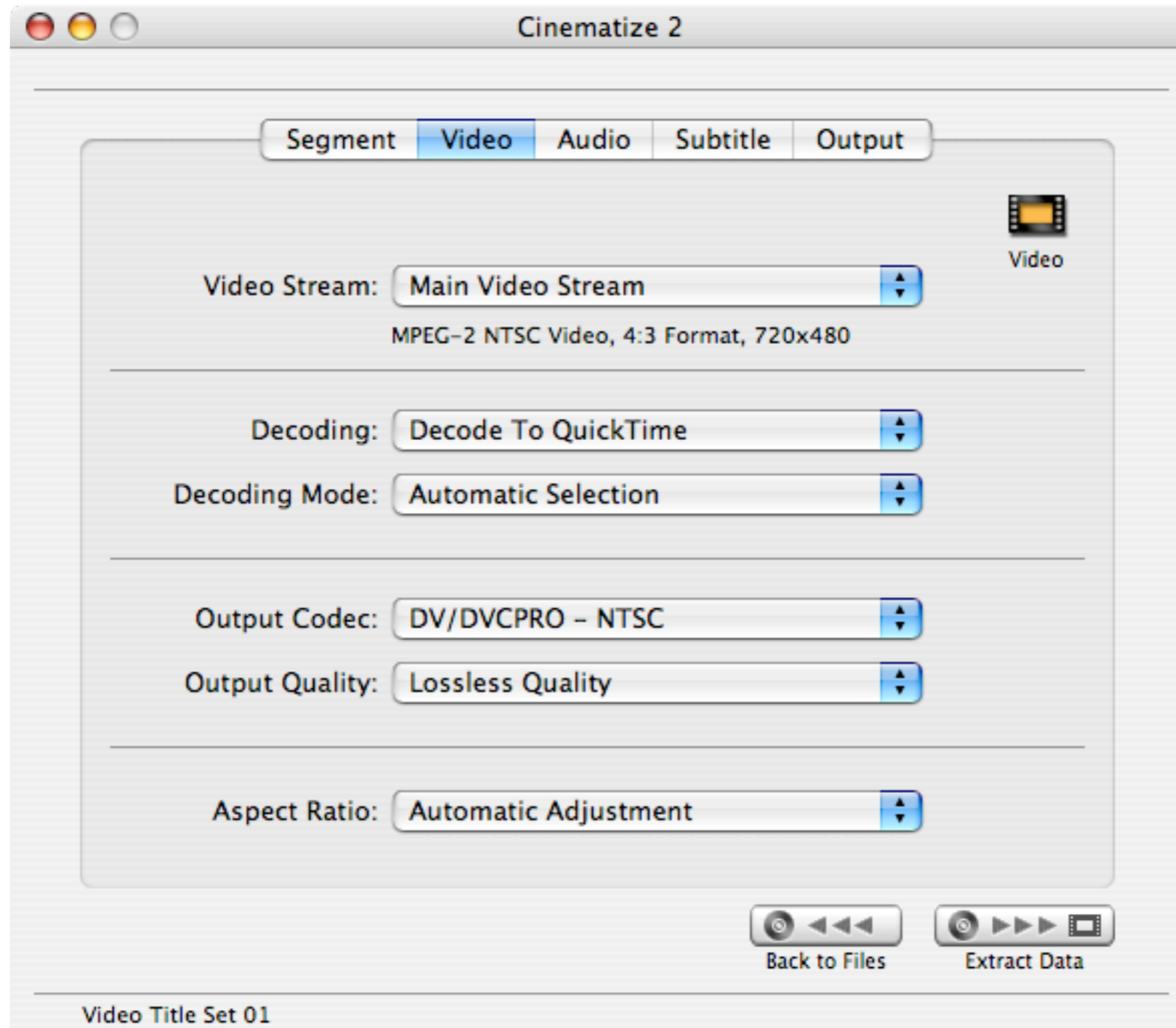
B) You can specify the start and end points by clicking their respective radio buttons and then choosing a chapter and then moving the slider.

C) It is possible to combine multiple chapters into one segment.



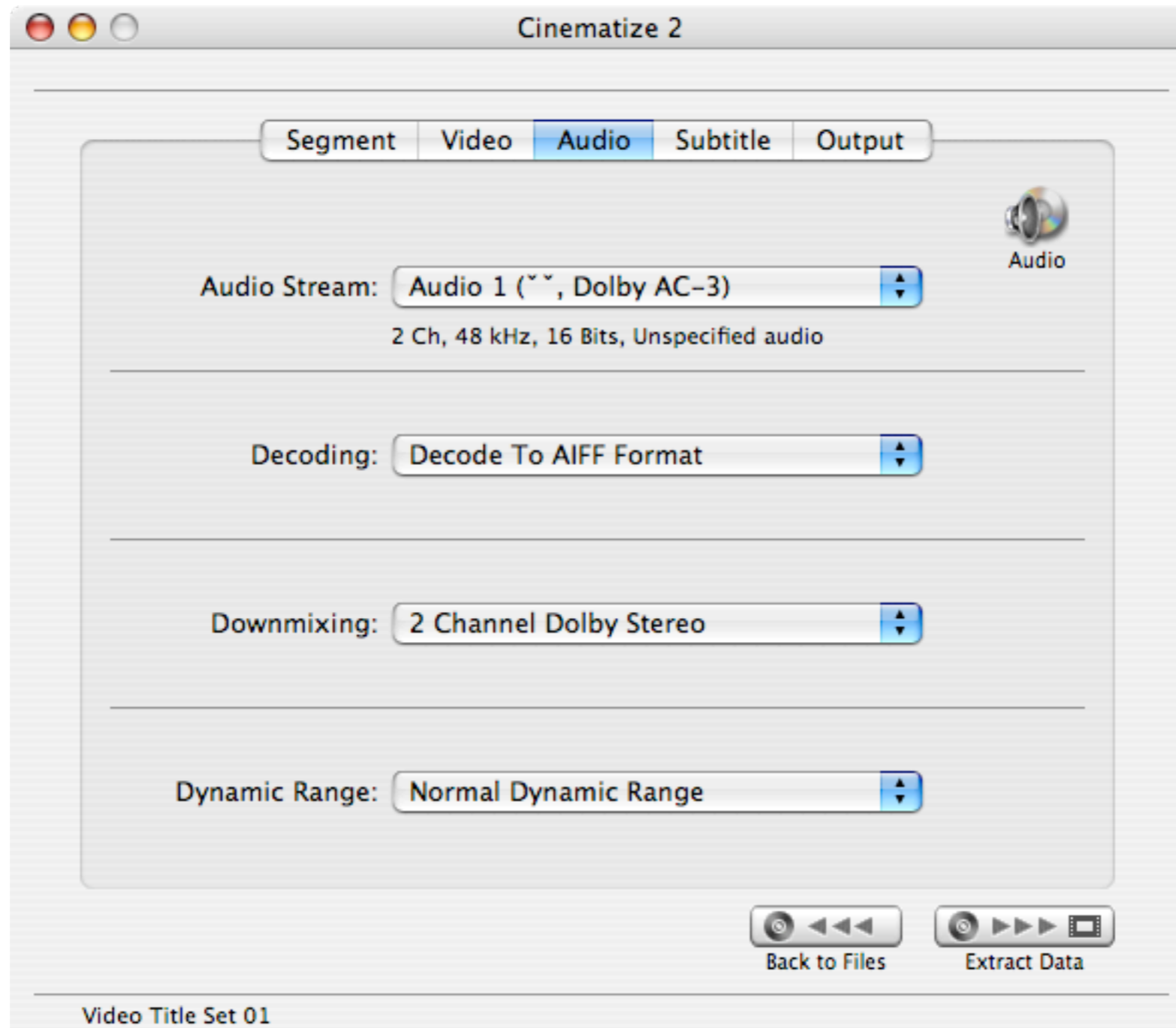
9) Video Tab

- A) Video Stream: Main Video Stream
- B) Decoding: Decode to QuickTime
- C) Decoding Mode: Automatic Selection
- D) Output Codec: DV/DVCPRO – NTSC
- E) Output Quality: Lossless Quality
- F) Aspect Ratio: Automatic Adjustment

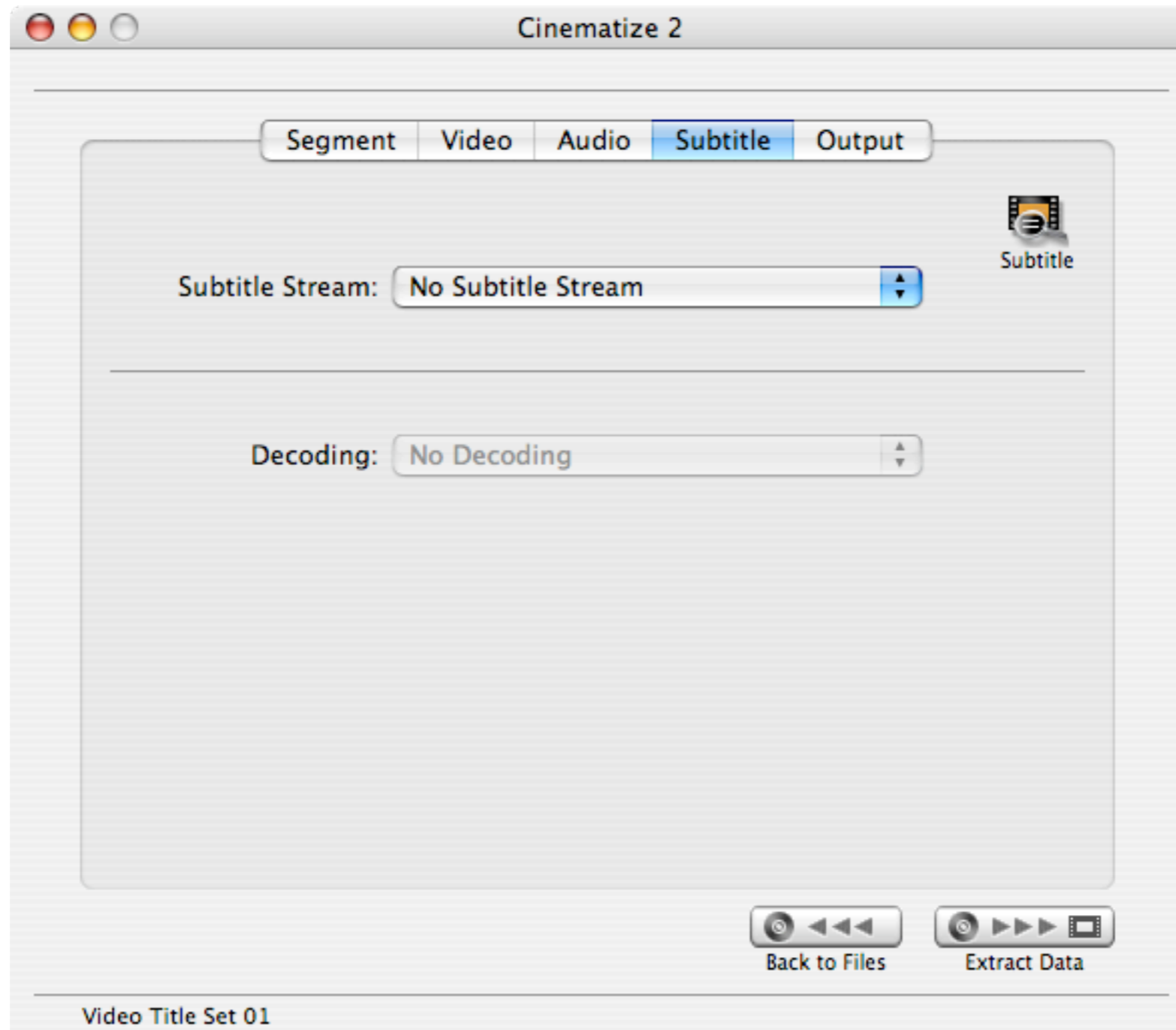


10) Audio Tab

- A) Audio Stream: Audio 1 or appropriate
- B) Decoding: Decode to AIFF Format
- C) Dynamic Range: Normal Dynamic Range



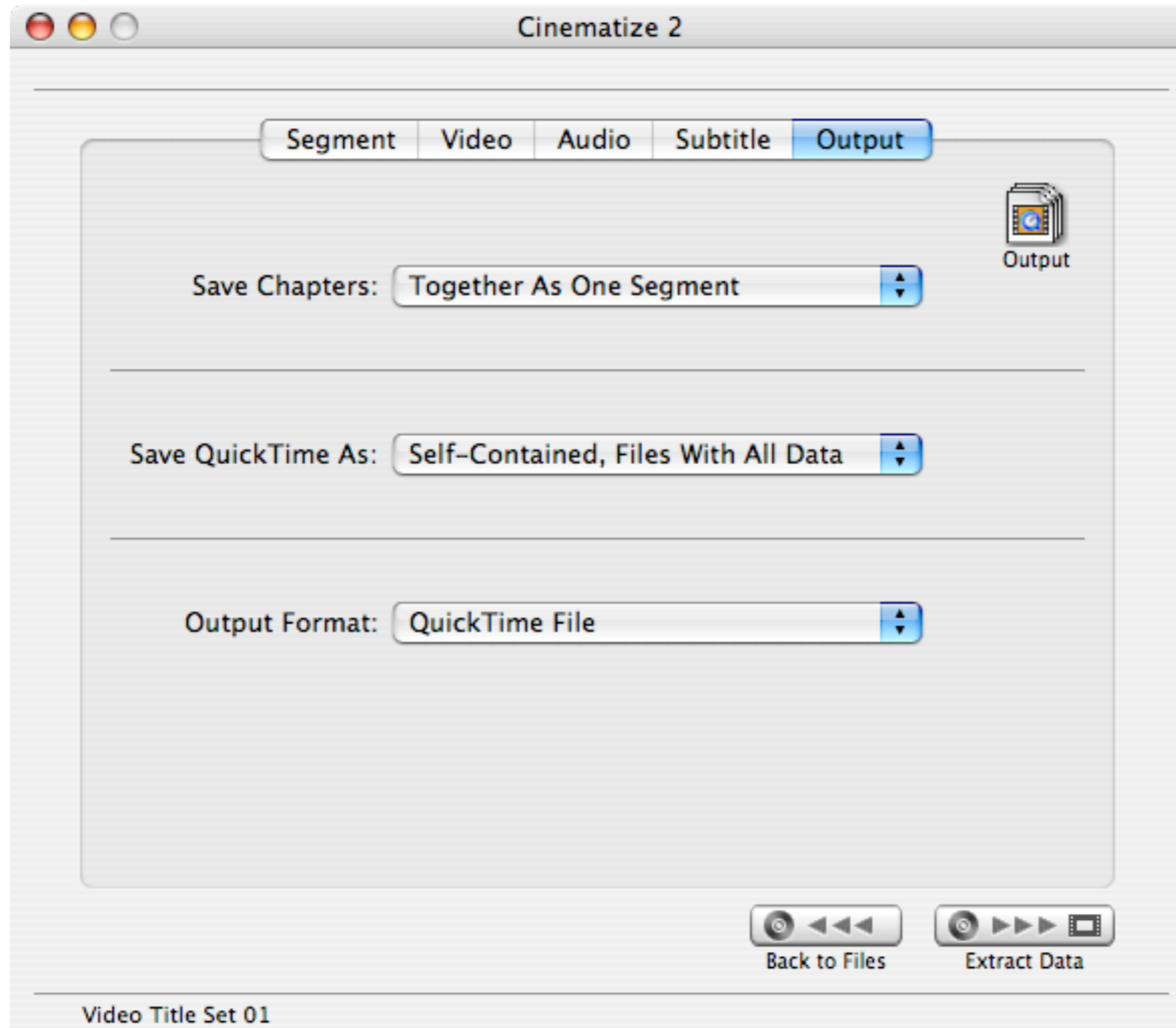
- 11) Subtitle Stream
A) No Subtitle Stream
B) Decoding grayed out



12) Output Stream

- A) Save Chapters: Together As One Segment
- B) Save QuickTime As: Self-Contained, Files With All Data
- C) Output Format: QuickTime File

13) Click the “Extract Data” button. Name and Save file to your Firewire Drive or Scratch Disk folder.



14) Drag the .mov file from the Finder into the Fincal Cut Browser window.
